
INCLUSIVE LEARNING COUNSELLING SERVICES



Elementary Counselling

The elementary counsellor:

may work with students to help with personal and social issues

may provide individual or small group sessions with students, conduct classroom sessions, consult with teachers and parents, provide parent and teacher education and training

may work with school-based or care teams to facilitate the contact with outside agencies

Roles and Responsibilities

The elementary counsellor may provide:

Counselling services for students

Consultation for parents, teachers, administrators and support staff

Liaison with community agencies

Integrated case management for students with behavioral designations.

These services focus on the following:

Social-emotional development

Preventative programs

Response to crisis situations

Referrals to clinical therapists

Accessing Counselling Services

The parent or guardian

The teacher or administrator

The school-based team

The student
