#### 9.1.1 Ministry Response to the 2023/2024 Annual Five-Year Capital Plan Submission

In July the Board submit ed the major capital and school infrastructure program request to Ministry of Educat on and Child Care. The Board received \$170,000 in capital funding to support implementat on of the Feeding Futures Fund through upgrades to kitchen equipment at a number of District schools. The upgrades will be phased in over the next year.


