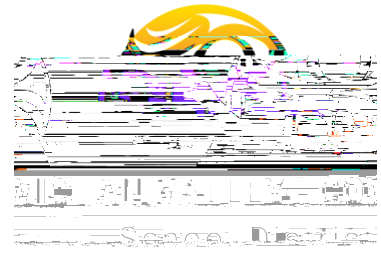


INCLUSIVE LEARNING COUNSELLING SERVICES



Elementary Counselling

The elementary counsellor:

- may work with students to help with personal and social issues

- may provide individual or small group sessions with students, conduct classroom sessions, consult with teachers and parents, provide parent and teacher education and training

- may work with school-based or care teams to facilitate the contact with outside agencies

Roles and Responsibilities

The elementary counsellor may provide:

- Counselling services for students
- Consultation for parents, teachers, administrators and support staff
- Liaison with community agencies
- Integrated case management for students with behavioral designations.

These services focus on the following:

- Social-emotional development
- Preventative programs
- Response to crisis situations
- Referrals to clinical therapists

Accessing Counselling Services

Counselling services can be requested by:

- The parent or guardian
- The teacher or administrator
- The school-based team
- The student

Signed parental or guardian consent is required.
